

ASTHMA POLICY

This pre-school welcomes all children with asthma and will:

- Encourage and help children with asthma to participate in all activities.
- Recognises that asthma is an important condition affecting many children.
- Recognises that immediate access to inhalers is vital.
- Will do all it can to make sure that our environment is favourable to children with asthma.
- Will ensure that children understand that some of their friends may have asthma and may occasionally need to use their inhalers whilst at pre-school.
- Staff are aware of the action to be taken in the event of a child having an asthma attack in accordance with parental instruction.
- Is aware that reliever medication for asthma is not harmful when used appropriately and that you cannot overdose on an inhaler.
- Ensure that inhalers are always taken on day trips or outside activities.
- Will work in partnership with parents, health professionals and other staff to ensure the successful implementation of the pre-school asthma policy.
